- Her bill, *Improving Legal Services for Female Veterans Act*, is now a law
- Protect the G.I. Bill and Post 9/11 G.I. Bill to help veterans earn a college degree
- Support military families with protection from fraud, support military spouses and children in their pursuit of jobs and education



Housing

- Strives for safe, affordable, high-quality housing for every American
- Helped deliver emergency rental assistance, *Homeowner Assistance fund*, and *Housing Choice Vouchers* to support the neediest in our community



Women and Families

- Fights for a woman's right to control her own body, make her own health care decisions, and have equal rights and protection in the workplace
- Supports women so our children, workplaces, and communities succeed



Jobs, Prosperity, and Labor Rights

- Works to protect our workers and to reduce the costs of apprenticeship programs
- Works to invest in our infrastructure, including rural broadband internet connections
- Strives to stabilize the economy, lower costs, and bring high-paying jobs home



Seniors

- Fights to protect Social Security and Medicare and oppose any budget cuts or efforts to privatize these programs
- Fights for other crucial programs that ensure a good quality of life for older Pennsylvanians



Health Care

- Continues to strengthen and expand the Affordable Care Act, close the Family Glitch loophole* that kept families from accessing affordable coverage for spouses and dependents, and lower the cost of prescription drugs

- Works to fight discrimination in schools, workplaces, housing, and anywhere else in our communities
