

Election Years for Federal-level and State-level Public Offices

Candidates are nominated and elected for the following state-level offices in the General Election years (even-numbered years) appropriate to the office they seek. Listed in Ballot Order.:

| Attorney General (4-year term) | 2024, 2028, 2032 |
| Auditor General (4-year term) | 2024, 2028, 2032 |
| State Treasurer (4-year term) | 2024, 2028, 2032 |
| Representative in US Congress (4-year term) | 2024, 2028, 2032 |
| PA Senator (4-year term) | |
| Even-numbered Districts | 2022, 2026, 2030 |
| Odd-numbered Districts | 2024, 2028, 2032 |
| PA Representative (2-year term) | 2024, 2026, 2028 |

Candidates are nominated and elected to the following state-level judicial offices in Municipal Election years (odd-numbered years):

Justice of the Supreme Court (10 year term, retention vote every 10 years)

Judge of the Superior Court (10 year term, retention vote every 10 years)

Judge of the Commonwealth Court (10 year term, retention vote every 10 years)

Judge of a Court of Common Pleas (10 year term, retention vote every 10 years)

Vacancies in judicial offices are ascertained prior to the start of the nomination petition circulation and filing period.
